# Highlights - July 9<sup>th</sup> Business Meeting

## Secretary Perlie Davis

- ▶ Jane Tolliver delivered the financial report for the 2018 reunion in Orlando, FL where 120 registered at \$100 per person. There was no profit.
- ▶ Discussed the reunion schedule. The next reunion will return to Florida. Jane Tolliver will be the area host.
- ▶ Family voted to set the reunion registration cap at \$125 with the intention that the host would work to keep the costs as low as possible.
- ▶ Family voted to accept Port Saint Lucie as the primary reunion location for 2024 with Miami/Dade as the backup location.
- ▶ Sponsorship was presented as an option for supporting registrations, particularly for families.
